Colour: Deep red

Nose: Blackberry and cassis on nose

Palate: Black berry flavours with hints of toffee, vanilla and soft tannins

IN THE VINEYARD

Climate: Mediterranean

Rainfall: 800mm - 1000mm per year

Soil: Good water holding capacity, dark clay with loose rocks on surface

Trellis system: Extended Perold

Irrigation: Micro

ABOUT THE HARVEST

When: End of March to first week in April at 24° - 27° Balling.

Yield: 14 tons/ha

IN THE CELLAR

Malolactic fermentation took place in new and second fill American and French medium toast oak barrels and matured for 15 months before bottling.
